MINUTES

The minutes of August 15, 2023 were approved upon the motion of James Hill and seconded by Paul Nelson. David Humphreys, Paul Nelson, David Hall, James Hill and Marci Doolan passed the motion with an affirmative vote.

WATER

A report on the water situation was given by Benjamin Quick. Precipitation for August was 1.08 inches and 1.03 inches month-to-date. The Ogden River Water Users' Association had their full allotment of water at the end of August.

PETITIONS

There was one petition for inclusion presented to the Board. After Board discussion, David Hall made a motion to include the petition (petition #3575) into the district. The motion was seconded by James Hill. David Humphreys, Paul Nelson, David Hall, James Hill and Marci Doolan passed the motion with an affirmative vote.

CONSTRUCTION Benjamin Quick gave the Board an update on the secondary water meter installations that have recently been completed within the district. In addition, he updated them of the progress that has taken place on the line replacements. After receiving multiple bids, AAA Excavation Inc. was awarded the line replacement project on a 4" PVC line from Henderson Drive between Cross and Tyler Ave.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Benjamin Quick informed the Board about a basement flooding that occurred on Robins Street. He has been working with the home owner to

remediate the property.

Mr. Quick discussed a grant application that he recently submitted to the State of Utah to request funding towards the North Pine Reservoir Project.
